- 7. Hong Kong, China (22°20'N, 114°11'E)
- 8. San Francisco, USA (37°46'N, 122°25'W)
- 9. Manila Bay, Philippines (14°35'N, 120°57'E)
- 10. Straits of Messina, Italy (38°14'N, 15°37'E)
- 11. Cape Horn, Chile (55°58'S, 67°16'W)
- 12. Nootka (Island), Canada (49°44'N, 126°45'W)
